Later in the game, the player takes on the role of John Marston and adapts to life outside the gang. Marston is also the protagonist of Red Dead Redemption. RDR2 takes place in virtual versions of the Western, Midwest, and Southern United States, modeled after states such as Louisiana, Missouri, and Wyoming. The main game's event features a set of stories a year ago and online multiplayer mode, in which players take on the silent protagonist on a mission to get revenge after being released from prison. Players can play alone or as a group of up to seven players to participate in stories and other activities. Battle Royale mode supports all four and three squads, and disables Automatic Squad Fill to prevent random people from participating in sessions and allow ing to play solo. In this case, the game goes into overtime and multiplies all the cash found 1.5 times. When the clock runs out, the team with the most money wins. In both modes, the player Resurrect when they die. In Battle Royale, players who are eliminated will be sent to Goulag, where they will fight one-on-one with other players and have the opportunity to resurrect. Tokens can also be purchased in in-game currency for regeneration. Predators automatically resurrect players who have been eliminated without being sent to Goulag. More focus on resurrected mechanics and vehicle use sets Warzone apart from the rest of the Battle Royale game. What we like in camera multiplayer mode with more modern controls is the remake of Resident Evil 3: Nemesis. The player plays the role of former Special Tactical and Rescue Service (S.T.A.R.S.) officer, Jill Valentine, as she tries to make her way through the zombie-infected raccoon city to find a cure for the T virus attacked by an umbrella-generating monster. The remake forges the use of the original game with fixed camera angles and tank controls for short moments of first-person control, as well as a more modern third-person shooter. Both the enemy and the protagonist have been redesigned to fit the action-driven style of gameplay, lending both a better sense of reality and horror to gameplay. The remake still features original core elements such as safe rooms and typewriters focused on storage as well as inventory management. The main storyline of Resident Evil 3 can be played for about six hours, meaning you can sit down or win two short sessions. Despite the short length of the game, Resident Evil 3 can still create a growing sense of fear and anxiety without being a cheese or ham fist. The online multiplayer mode is also included in a game set up for masterminds where four players can set traps and create enemies.
